Each year, around 300,000 women worldwide die during and following pregnancy and childbirth. We must significantly accelerate progress to meet global targets for reducing maternal deaths, or else risk the lives of over 1 million more women by 2030.

The far majority of maternal and newborn deaths are preventable if women have access to basic quality care from a skilled healthcare professional during pregnancy and childbirth.

Maternity Foundation has documented and proven solutions, and to date has reached and supported more than 435,000 healthcare professionals worldwide. But the need is much higher and we have only just started.

Partnership is key

Maternity Foundation is scaling up and have a target of ensuring 10 million safer births by end 2030.

To that end, we are thrilled to have launched our Global Maternity Partners Programme this year, partnering with a few key, global strategic partners to help realize our ambitious targets and accelerate our growth.

Global Maternity Partners consists of a small group of high-profile investors, each of whom shares our common goal - to ensure safer childbirths worldwide. Maternity Foundation has built a sustainable and cost-effective model, working together with partners such as UNFPA, UNICEF, Ministries of Health, Red Cross, and Plan International.
